The Breakthrough to Nursing Director shall:

- 1. Serve as the chairperson of the Breakthrough to Nursing Committee.
- 2. Be responsible for the promotion of career opportunities in nursing.
- 3. Focus substantially upon increasing the number of students from groups who traditionally have been underrepresented in American nursing.
- 4. Encourage and promote participation of students from all backgrounds, including but not limited to race, ethnicity, gender, and socioeconomic status.
- 5. Encourage the nursing education system to be more responsive to the needs of the above students.
- 6. Submit a Breakthrough to Nursing Project to the Communications Director and Regional Directors to disperse to school chapters by the third (3rd) month in office and keep the Board of Directors informed of the goals and progress of the projects.
- 7. Establish and/or maintain communication with the local/individual school chapter Breakthrough to Nursing directors.
- 8. Assist school chapters as needed in developing recruitment materials and guidelines for recruitment in their areas.
- 9. Coordinate and submit the Annual NSNA Breakthrough to Nursing Award application.
- 10. Present the Breakthrough to Nursing Project at the annual House of Delegates meeting.
- 11. Coordinate and submit the monthly NSNA Breakthrough to Nursing Award applications.
- 12. Be responsible for providing an annual committee report at the annual House of Delegates meeting.
- 13. Perform all other duties as assigned.
